*You are hereby granted permission to perform the necessary grading and to construct in accordance with the attached plan one (1) entrance(s) to a commercial use at a point on the north side of Rt. 2, 9,046 feet east of the New Sharon-Farmington T.L. subject to the Rules and Regulations made by the Department of Transportation, Bureau of Highways and dated 7/12/72 and subject to the following conditions.*

Applicant shall furnish a new 15" x 30' culvert and construct a gravel entrance as shown on the attached sketch.

The grade of the entrance(s) shall slope away from the road surface at a rate of one-half (1/2) inch per foot to provide for a low spot three (3) feet beyond the edge of the existing shoulder, but not less than five (5) feet from the edge of pavement. Areas adjacent to the highway shall be graded so that surface water shall be carried away from the highway.

A new permit shall be required whenever (re)paving, a grade change, widening, or relocation is planned.

**THIS PERMIT IS GRANTED ON CONDITION THAT THE OWNER:**

- (1) Shall provide, erect and maintain all necessary barricades, lights, warning signs, and other devices to safeguard traffic properly while work is in progress
- (2) Shall at no time cause the highway to be closed to traffic.
- (3) Shall, where the driveway is located in a curb, curb and gutter, and/or sidewalk section, completely remove the existing curb, curb and gutter, and/or sidewalk and replace with standard concrete or granite driveway terminal section, and replace such curb, curb and gutter and/or sidewalk as may be required.
- (4) Shall obtain, and have delivered to site, any culverts and/or other drainage structures which may be necessary for drainage. Culverts shall be Aluminium Coated Corrugated Metal Pipe, Type 2, (ALCCMP) the size type, and length as called for in this permit. Said culverts and/or other incidentals to be installed by Maine Department of Transportation, unless otherwise designated.
- (5) Shall in all cases notify the Division office at least 24 hours before starting work on the driveway.
- (6) Shall construct proposed entrance within 12 months from date of permit issue.
- (7) Shall meet all applicable D.E.P., L.U.R.C., and municipal regulations and ordinances.

IT IS A FURTHER CONDITION OF THIS PERMIT, to which owner agrees by accepting the same, owner shall well and truly pay all damages, fines and penalties for which he shall become liable, and shall save harmless and indemnify said department against all suits, claims, damages and proceedings of every kind arising out of the construction and maintenance of said driveway approach, including snow removal.

It is a further condition that the owner will agree to keep the right of way inviolate for public highway purposes, and no signs (other than traffic signs and signals), posters, billboards, roadside stands culvert end walls, or other private installations shall be permitted within the Right of Way Limits.

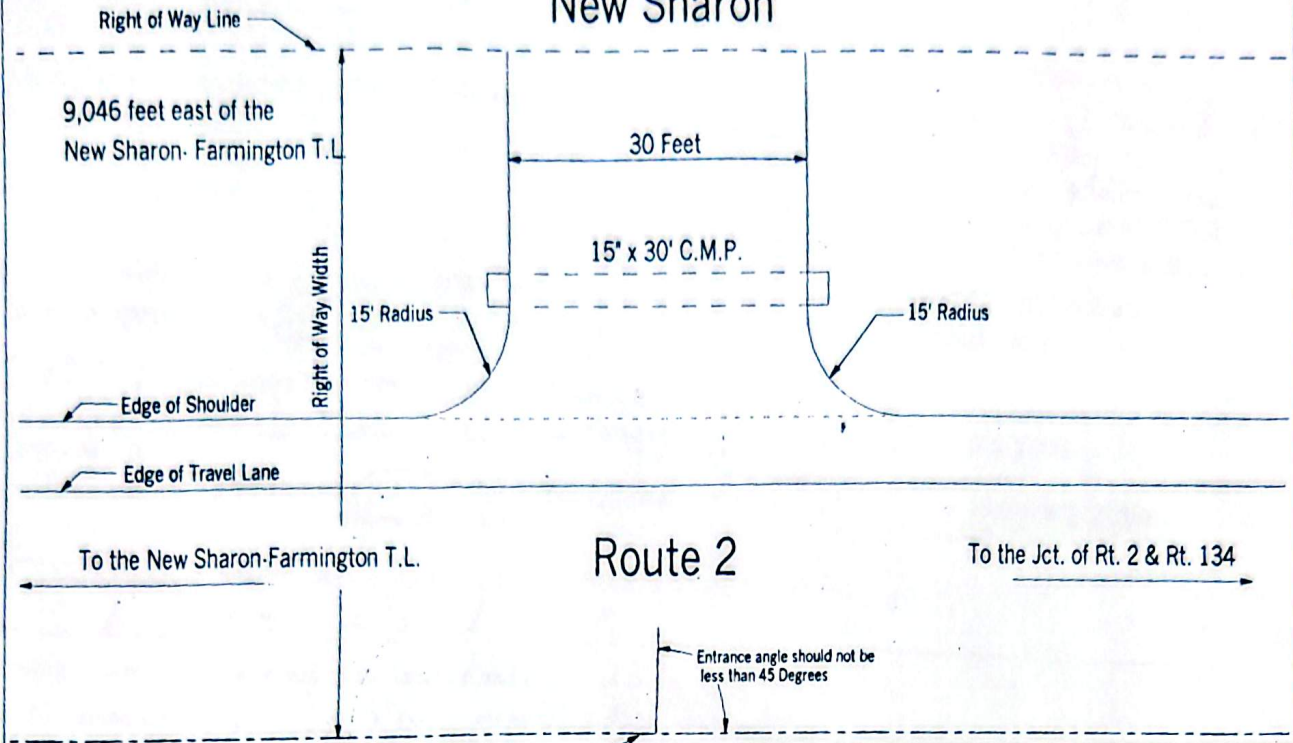

Shall obtain and have delivered to the site any culverts and/or drainage structures which may be necessary for drainage, the size, type and length as called for in this permit. Said culverts and/or other incidentals to be installed by the Maine Department of Transportation, unless otherwise designated.

In all cases to Notify the Division Office at least 24 hours before starting work on the driveway.

To construct and maintain said driveway approach in accordance with Maine Department of Transportation, Rules and Regulations".

OTHER CONDITION OF THE PERMIT: shall be that the owner shall well and truly pay all damages, fines, and penalties which he shall become liable, and shall indemnify and save harmless said Department against all suits, claims, damages proceedings of every kind arising out of the construction and maintenance of said driveway approach, including snow removal.
