The acreage is stocked with primarily Douglas-fir and Sitka Spruce with some Cedar and Hemlock growing on highly productive soils, predominantly Site Class II and III sites. Operations can be conducted year-round given the favorable climate, soils and established road systems.

The timber stands will be available for harvest within a decade or so, providing strong cash flows. The property is positioned well to deliver a varied product mix into a very strong market with consistent demand from local mills and export facilities.

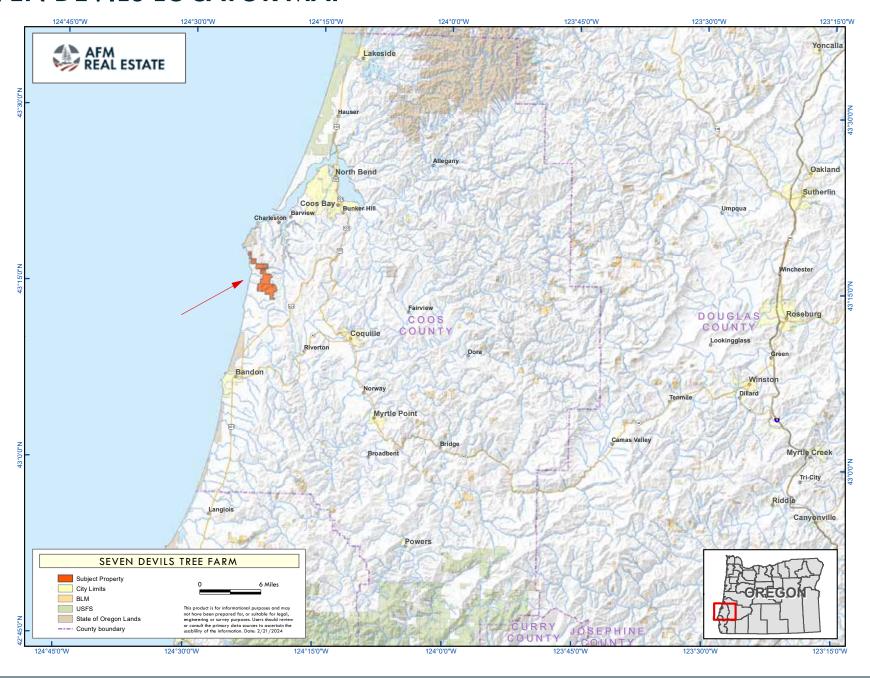
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## **SEVEN DEVILS LOCATOR MAP**

There appear to be eleven parcels, possibly more, that could support a single-family dwelling More information can be found in the data room. Most of the lots would potentially qualify under the Large Tract 160 Acre Contiguous CUP method and the 200-Acre Non-Contiguous CUP method. With the Non-Contiguous method a restrictive covenant would need to be placed on the acreage not supporting a home site. The covenant would not allow single-family dwellings in perpetuity; however, forestry and other uses are allowed.

The acreage is primarily covered in a lush conifer forest, mostly Douglas-fir and Sitka Spruce, with some Cedar and Western Hemlock on flat to rolling terrain. Some steeper ground is found scattered through the block.

The majority of the property stretches from the cliffs of the Pacific Ocean to the productive inland forests abutting Beaver Hill and Seven Devils County roads. Views of the Pacific Ocean and Bandon Dunes Golf Resort can be found in many locations. Bandon Dunes Golf Resort is only 15-20 minutes away!

The proximity to the renown Bandon Dunes Golf Resort brings unmatched opportunities for building golf-themed homes catering to serious groups of golfers. World-class fishing opportunities are nearby in Charleston and Coos Bay. Many other options exist for this unique property.

There is the potential to construct single-family dwellings on at least eleven lots, many with expansive views when home sites are cleared. Power is located in the north and south sections of the property where the home sites would be located. The remainder of the property is a working forest generating significant, periodic income from timber harvest and specialty forest products.

There are also options for a buyer to generate additional income from recreation leases and specialty forest products.

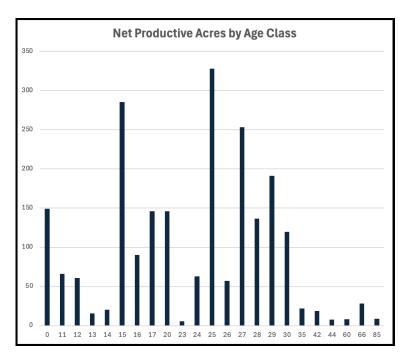
The timber is primarily pre-merchantable Douglas-fir and Sitka Spruce, with some Cedar and Western hemlock, growing on productive, predominately Class II & III sites.

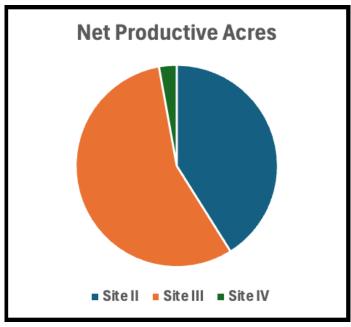
This coastal Oregon softwood plantation totals 2,228± Net Productive acres, 98% being 0-44 years. With an average age of approximately 22 years and an average Douglas-fir site index of 119 (King 50), the property is very well positioned for strong biological growth, product shifts, price appreciation, and consistent long-term cash flow.

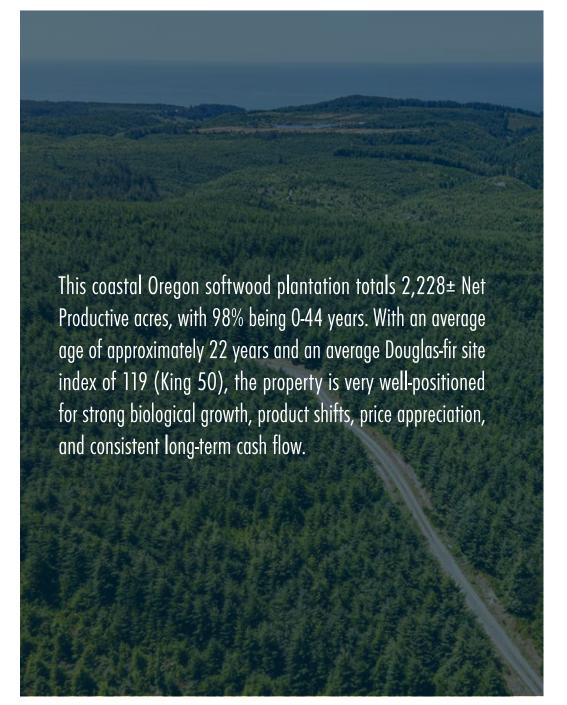
Approximately 92% of the property is classified as Net Productive\* acres suitable for forest management. Buyers will need to deduct future stream buffer acres and volume.

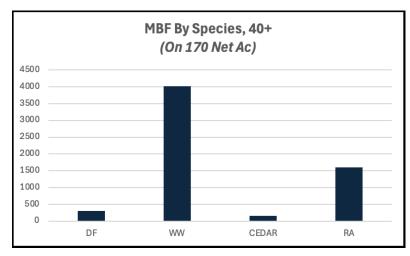

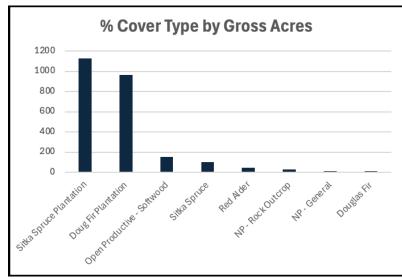

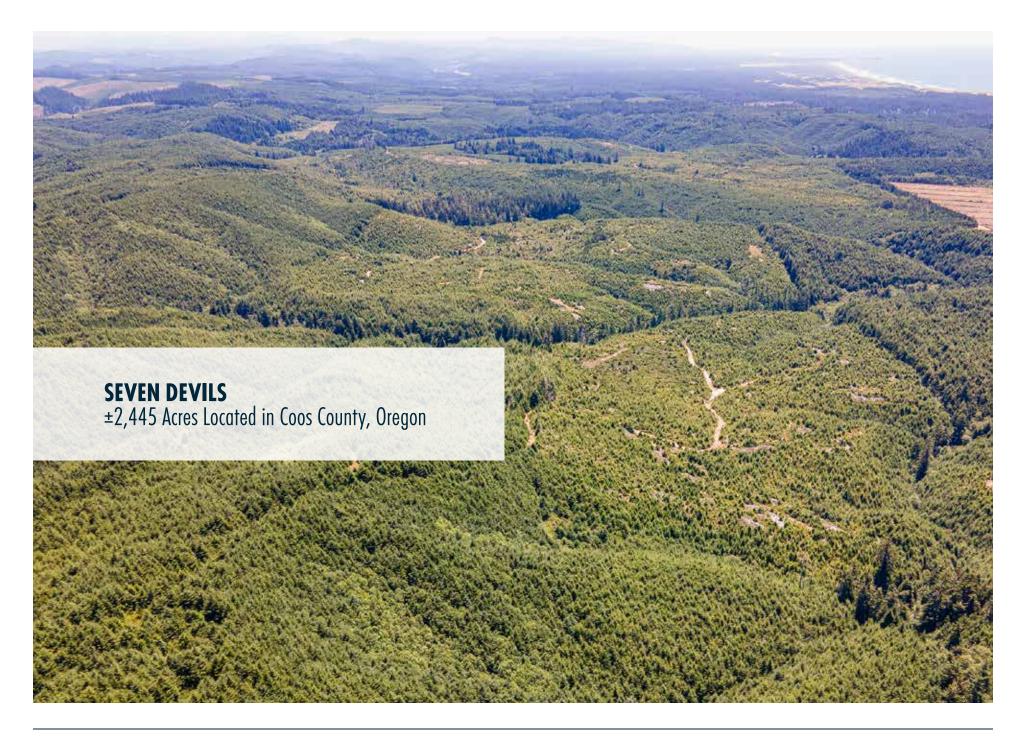














### **Property Visits and Tours**
