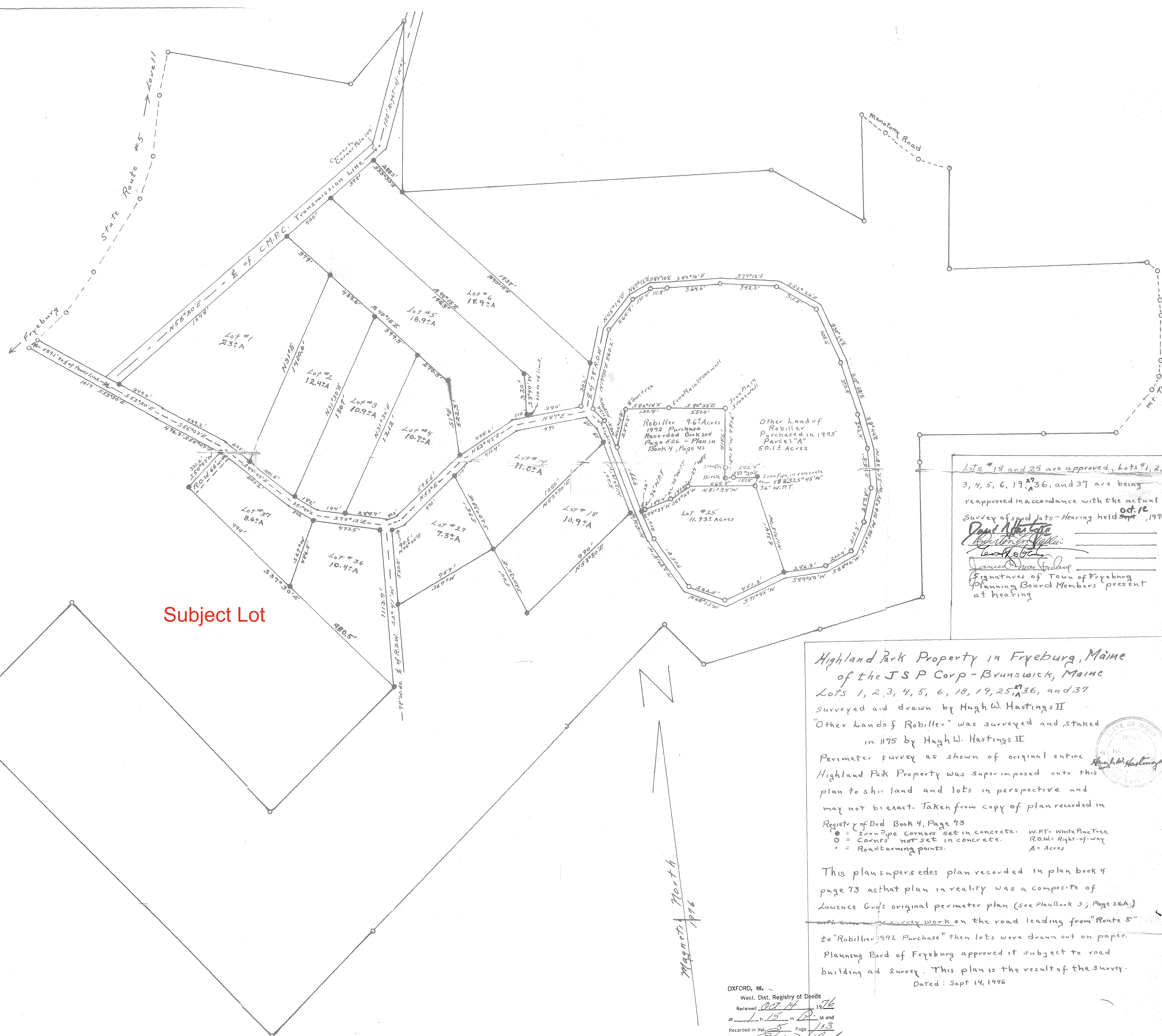

page 73 as that plan in reality was a composite of  
Lawrence G. G's original perimeter plan (see Plan Book 3; Page 36A.)  
with some survey work on the road leading from "Route 5"  
to "Robiller 1972 Purchase" then lots were drawn out on paper.  
Planning Board of Fryeburg approved it subject to road  
building and survey. This plan is the result of the survey.
